Another kick-off meeting between the Beneficiary and the Service Provider shall be held at the Beneficiary's premises in Bucharest shortly after the project start, with the participation of the EIB relevant staff.

The intended commencement date is **mid-May 2017** and the period of implementation of the Contract will be **22 months** from this date.
